#### REMINDER

The use of pace notes is strictly forbidden as per R25.9.1. The organisers will appoint Judges of Fact whose duties may include carrying out searches for notes. The organisers will supply a map of the stages, which may be used.

**SCRUTINY SATURDAY MORNING:-** Scrutiny and sign-on will begin on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> August for all competitors.

This will take place between 6:00AM and 9:00AM to assist with administration on the morning, and get an early start.

1. SATURDAY MORNING - Shackleton complex will open at 6.00a.m. Entry via main gate from traffic lights in Ballykelly Village  
**PLEASE BE AWARE – Major road works are taking place in Ballykelly Village and there is usually single lane traffic during the day. Extra time may be required for the journey.**
2. One Service vehicle & Service crew for each competing Rally Car.[ NO EXCEPTIONS. ANY OTHER VEHICLES ENTER VIA SPALLAN ROAD; SECURITY HAVE BEEN INFORMED SO PLEASE ADHERE TO THIS REQUEST].
3. Scrutiny will commence at 6.00a.m. Please come early and please adhere to the Marshals instructions, who will be looking after the service area parking - MAKE GOOD USE OF PARKING IN SERVICE AREA.
4. Main Gates to Shackleton Complex will close at 8:30 a.m. SHARP; there will be NO ENTRY VIA THESE GATES AFTER 8:30 A.M.
5. Please follow the instructions and direction given by marshals. Competitors will take the shortest route to and from the Scrutiny venue, anyone reported to COC for going off route may be reported to Stewards and excluded.

6. A reminder to competitors to ensure you have the required FHR (HANS) devices for scrutiny and the requirement to wear the device for the duration of the competitive sections of the event.
7. Competitors must fulfil the requirement for the correct SEATS and SEATBELTS for the event. Non compliance will lead to NON-START.
8. Once your car has passed Scrutiny, collect Door Plates [competition numbers] and make your way to Rally Office & Sign On to collect your Rally Packs.  
Reminder about strict rules on Stage Viewing – on foot / bicycle only – no motorised vehicles, followed by strict embargo on use of bicycles during the remainder of the day. **NO PERSON WILL BE PERMITTED TO USE ANY FORM OF MOTORISED OR PEDAL TRANSPORT IN OR AROUND THE SERVICE AREA / SPECTATOR AREAS AFTER 09.00HRS - THIS PARTICULARLY APPLIES TO CHILDREN.**  
If any person ignoring these instructions is connected to a competitor he/she will **BE EXCLUDED. THIS IS FOR EVERYBODYS SAFETY AND WILL BE ENFORCED**
9. Drivers Briefing at 9:00a.m. Sharp with expected start for SS1 at 10:00am.
10. Competitors are required to have all forms completed for sign-on at paper scrutiny, so **PLEASE, PLEASE** download proper forms and have completed.
11. Navigators applying for 1<sup>st</sup> licence on the day only! – bring a signed passport size photograph to send with licence application. Licence fee - Non-Race National B (Not EU) LEA £46 + £10 MCMC membership
